## GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates are advised to read the instructions carefully before filling up the application form and dispatching it.

The minimum qualifications required for appointment in the University as laid down by the UGC (approved by the Government in G.O.Ms.No.14 Higher Education (UE.II) Dept. dated 20-2-2010 and contained in the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2010 *vide* No.F.3-1/2009, dt. 30-06-2010) and University Grants Commission (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) (4<sup>th</sup> Amendment), Regulations, 2016, G.O.Ms.No.38 Higher Education (UE) Department, dated 23.06.2016 for the posts of Professors. ### Minimum Qualifications prescribed for Appointment of Teaching Faculty for English, Journalism and Mass Communication, Applied Mathematics, Biosciences & Biotechnology, Chemistry, and Physics.

- A. i. An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- ii. A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college, and/or experience in research at the University/National level institutions/industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- iii. Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process.
- iv. A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in "University Grants Commission (Minimum qualifications for appointment of teachers and other academic staff in Universities and colleges and measures for the maintenance of standards in higher educations) (4<sup>th</sup> amendment) regulations 2016".

OR

- B. An outstanding professional, with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/ allied/ relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

### NOTE:

- a) A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks at the graduate and master's level for the SC / ST / Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions.
- b) A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of marks to Ph.D. degree holders, who passed their Master's degree examination prior to 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1991.
- c) B in 7 points scale with letter grade O, A, B, C, D, E & F shall be regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed.
